Ginny also trains and supports Crossroads' volunteers who participate in the Community Chaplain Training Program. Crossroads members are encouraged to complete the training offered by this program so they can respond to people in their regular routines who might need the encouragement that only a Christian can offer.

Some members of our fellowship are also 'Commissioned' as Community Chaplains because they have adopted a 'piece of the community' where they pursue opportunities to be a Chaplain to others. Among the many topics discussed in the Community Chaplain Training are: suicide, financial crises, evangelism, marriage and divorce, substance abuse, and grief. These trained volunteers designate an area of their lives as their ministry and come alongside people, encouraging them, helping them, and pointing them toward Christ.
