Jojo and Wendy are our global missionaries with D.O.O.R. International stationed in Africa. They have served for many years already with D.O.O.R. and we have come to appreciate their strategic role at DOOR. The Deaf represent the unreached people group we have felt led to put a major focus on serving. Mike & Linda Buus, the directors of D.O.O.R., are also Crossroads Fellowship Missionaries serving this people group. This is part of our major partnership strategy to go deep with a few agencies. Adding the Ninan's to our missionary team is our next step in the effort.

Our partnership has grown since 2001 so we can now embrace our first international couple within this agency. Jojo and Wendy are not from Raleigh or Crossroads Fellowship. However, we believe the unique role they both play in this spearheading movement to reach the Deaf of India and Africa challenge us to come alongside them as one of their major donor churches. We believe they represent the new paradigm of missions for the twenty first century.

Jojo is wonderfully fluent in the primary sign languages D.O.O.R. uses in India and Africa. He pioneered the church planters training curriculum and pastoral tools. When the Bible translation opportunity fell to D.O.O.R. in partnership with Wycliffe, he and Wendy were the natural choice to lead the development and oversight of the 6 to 8 teams [of 4 to 5 people each] that are actively translating the Bible for the first time into their native sign languages. It is a huge undertaking and we are honored to be able to support such a gifted couple who have sacrificed considerably to help D.O.O.R. reach the level of impact and effectiveness it enjoys today.
