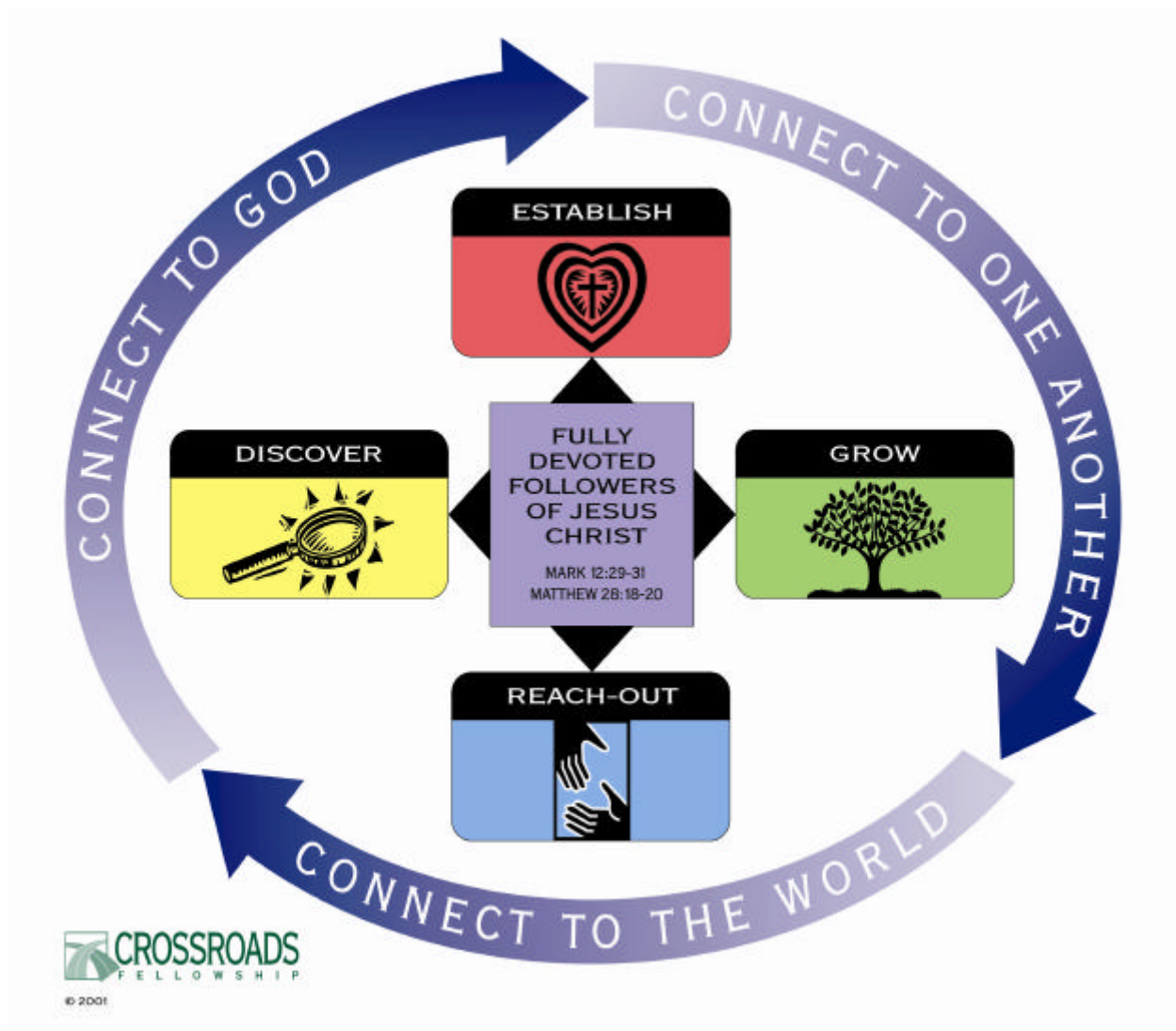


Your Personal Growth Plan

Where Am I Right Now?

Key Questions *to consider as you create action steps this year:*

- Do you have any doubts or questions about the existence of God, the deity of Jesus Christ, the trustworthiness of the Bible, or God's plan of Salvation which you need to investigate further?
- Do you understand the **basic beliefs** and **doctrines** of Christianity well enough to explain them to someone else?
- Do you need help understanding and practicing the 'Lifestyle Disciplines' taught by Jesus Christ?
 - **Private Worship** (i.e., daily Bible reading and prayer)
 - **Corporate Worship** (i.e., participating in church services with others)
 - **Fellowship** (i.e., spending time with other believers)
 - **Outreach** (i.e., spending time with unbelievers)
 - **Stewardship** (i.e., giving time & money to help the local church reach the community and the world)
 - **Evangelism** (i.e., listening to, praying for and serving others as you share your spiritual journey)
- Do you need help finding healing from pain in your past or breaking free from some harmful addiction or destructive pattern?

Key Decisions *we recommend everyone make each year:*

Connect

Join a Small Group, a Ministry Team, or a class on Sunday morning or during the week.

Grow

Have a daily time with God to read the Bible and pray.

Serve

Volunteer to use your gifts/abilities to help with one of the many ministries at Crossroads Fellowship.
